NEWS FROM CLAYTON TAYLOR, AIA OK LEGISLATIVE LIAISON

“Good news to report HB 3024 passed on the House and Senate floor before adjournment. This legislation provides that the Historic tax credits will “accrue” during the two years is in the moratorium. Beginning July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2012 Historic tax credits accrue and then can be collected in the taxable year beginning January 1, 2012. Historic tax credits, Wind tax credit and Investment tax credits to create jobs were the only tax credits previously suspended in SB 1267 that were reconsidered and allowed to accrue during the time of their suspension. As I understand it, we will get all of our tax credits, but just not for 2 years. We believe that the Governor has agreed to these three tax credits and will sign the legislation sometime between now and June 12th.”
